Directions

From Northern Virginia – Traveling from I-95 South take Exit 84B Route 1-295 North towards Charlottesville. Take I-295 North 8 miles to the I-64 interchange. Take I-64 East Exit 53B. Travel 2 miles and take Gaskins Road South Exit 180A. Merge onto Gaskins Road. Go 0.5 miles through the first traffic light at Three Chopt Road. Make first right turn after the light into the Gaskins Professional Office Park complex. Our office is the 1st building on the right.

From the Southside area – Traveling from Chippenham Parkway North/Parham Road turn left onto Three Chopt Road. Go 1.3 miles and then turn left onto Gaskins Road. Make the first right into the Gaskins Professional Office Park complex. Our office is the first building on the right.

From the East - Take I-64 west towards Charlottesville. Take Gaskins Road South Exit 180A. Merge onto Gaskins Road. Go 0.5 miles through the first traffic light at Three Chopt Road. Make the first right turn after the light into the Gaskins Professional Office Park complex. Our office is the first building on the right.

To Exit the Office Complex – It is best to leave from the Three Chopt Road entrance/exit. When leaving the office turn right on the complex's main access road. Travel through the complex until you reach the end of the office park. Make a right turn onto Three Chopt Road. The first light is Gaskins Road. Turn left at the light to go to the I-64 interchange.

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Cosmetic SURGERY PROCEDURES

All cosmetic surgery consultations are complimentary. Insurance co-pays, co-insurance and deductibles will apply for consultations and procedures submitted to your insurance company.



BODY

Abdominoplasty (Tummy Tuck): Firm and tighten the abdomen by removing excess skin and fat, tightening the underlying rectus abdominis (6-pack muscles), and hide the scar under the underwear or bathing suit.

Brachioplasty (Removal of Excess Upper Arm Skin): Often performed after massive weight loss, improve the contour of the arms by removing excess skin.

Bra-Line Back Lift (Removal of Excess Upper Back Skin): Often performed after massive weight loss, improve upper back contour by removing excess skin.

Thigh Lift: Often performed after massive weight loss, improve the contour of the thighs by removing excess skin.

Liposuction: Most effective for localized areas of excess fat, remove unwanted fat collections that stubbornly persist despite diet and exercise. Achieve optimal body contour.

BREAST

Augmentation: Obtain a fuller appearance of the breast with the use of silicone or saline breast implants.

Lift: Obtain a younger, firmer appearance of the breast by tightening sagging breast skin and repositioning the nipple and areola.

Reduction: Reduce back and neck pain and improve the breast balance and proportion by removing excess breast tissue and skin and repositioning the nipple and areola.

Gynecomastia (Male Breast Removal): Obtain a chiseled chest contour by removing unwanted male breast tissue.

FACE

Brow Lift: Restores youthful upper face appearance by smoothing forehead wrinkles and repositioning brows.

Upper & Lower Blepharoplasty (Eyelid Surgery): Obtain a rejuvenated, youthful eye appearance by removing excess skin on upper and lower lids, removing unwanted bulges and restoring volume to hollow tired appearing eyes.

Face Lift: Return to a more youthful version of yourself by repositioning sagging facial structures, restoring volume where deficient, and removing excess skin; often performed in conjunction with a neck lift for optimal restoration of cosmetic facial balance.

Neck Lift: Achieve a more youthful neckline by removing excess skin and unwanted bulges and alleviating neck bands due to underlying platysma muscle.

Otoplasty (Ear Reshaping): Reduce and reposition prominent ears; repair torn or stretched earlobes.

Rhinoplasty (Nose Reshaping): Achieve cosmetic balance to the face by reshaping a less than ideal nose appearance.

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Reconstructive SURGERY PROCEDURES

Breast Reconstruction: Restore breast shape and volume through the use of implants or your own (autologous) tissue from the abdomen or back after mastectomy for breast cancer therapy.



Skin Cancer: Remove basal cell carcinoma and squamous cell carcinoma and reconstruct the resultant defect with an appreciation for optimal aesthetics.

Melanoma Surgery: Remove this dangerous form of skin cancer and reconstruct the resultant defect with an appreciation for optimal aesthetics.

Skin Lesion Removal: Remove benign (non-cancerous) skin lesions.

Carpal Tunnel: Alleviate tingling and numbness in the hands by releasing the pressure on the median nerve at the wrist.

Dupuytren's Surgery: Restore hand mobility by excising scar tissue in the palm associated with this disabling disease known as Dupuytren's palmar fibromatosis.

Ganglion Cyst Removal: Remove benign unwanted bumps or lumps on the fingers, hands or wrists.
