After Care

Post Biopsy or Post Curettage (scraping)

Check below for information on how to care for your wound following a biopsy or curettage.

- 1. A bandage has been placed over the site(s). Leave this in place for 24 hours.
- 2. Cleanse the area(s) daily with soap and water. You may shower or bathe.
- 3. Apply Vaseline and keep covered with a bandaid.
- 4. Change dressing daily until area has healed.
- 5. If bleeding is noted, apply pressure to the area for 15 minutes by the clock. If this does not stop the bleeding please call the office.
- 6. Tylenol (acetaminophen) can be taken for pain if needed.
- 7. If a biopsy was taken, your results will be here in approximately two weeks.

PLEASE NOTE:

Charges for laboratory work (biopsy, cultures, blood work) are billed separately and **not included** in the bills you recieve from the doctor's office. If you have any questions or problems regarding your laboratory bill, please contact the laboratory directly.
